


Coastal Climate InitiativeTeam Up to Help Protect our Coast

Be Aware of NJNG Impostors

Scammers use all kinds of tactics to trick you into giving them your money and personal information. Stay alert to protect yourself from fraud:

- Phone calls from NJNG representatives will never pressure you into immediate payments or solicit personal and banking information.
- Emails from NJNG are sent from @njng.com or @4you.njng.com. Always check the sender's address to verify this information.
- Always verify the identity of anyone claiming to be a representative from NJNG, whether at your doorstep or on the phone. NJNG employees always carry ID and all our commercial vehicles prominently display our logo.

Stay alert for a "slamming" scam where you are switched to another energy supplier without your authorization. Use precaution and do not to share your NJNG account number or natural gas bill with anyone unless you are intending to switch energy providers.

In case of any disruptions, accessing your property may be necessary to restore your natural gas service. Make sure that if you are not home or unreachable, you have provided an emergency contact to NJNG so we can help get your service back up and running in a timely manner.

Important Message for **Customers Who Rely on** Life-Sustaining Equipment

If you or a member of your household depends on life-sustaining equipment and use a natural gas generator during a power outage, please notify NJNG. In the event of a natural gas outage, it is vital we have your information on record so we can help ensure prompt restoration of your service. Please complete the medical certification form online at the My Home section of njng.com and select Services for Special Needs.

Corrugated Stainless Steel Tubing

Corrugated stainless steel tubing (CSST) is commonly used for fuel lines (starting from your meter's outlet into your home) to supply natural gas to residential and commercial customers. CSST must be installed and used only in accordance with applicable codes and manufacturers' instructions, including those that pertain to bonding and grounding of the piping system. The owner of the structure where the CSST is used should consider installing an appropriate lightning protection system.

CSST requires proper bonding and grounding to be protected from lightning strikes. Contact a licensed electrician for a professional inspection.
