Subject to approval by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities, typical residential heating customers, using 100 therms per month, will see bill decreases of \$10.24 or 9.3 percent effective October.

Plan before You Leave: Winterize Your Home

Closing up your summer house? Leaving for an extended time during the winter? Take heed to these tips to help winterize your home:

- Adjust the thermostat to 55 degrees to help keep water pipes from freezing and bursting. (Consider installing a low-temperature sensor that alerts your alarm monitoring company when your home's temperature drops below an established setting.)
- Unplug electrical appliances and avoid energy hogs.
- Turn off your water from the main source and open all taps to drain remaining water to avoid pipes from freezing.

Proper access to your home will help us promptly restore natural gas service in the event of disruption and avoid potential property damage.

Before You Turn up the Heat ...

Gearing up for the heating season takes a bit of preparation toward energy-efficiency and savings. Here are a few tidbits to help you get ready before the winter season begins:

- Ensure your heating system is operating at peak performance with an inspection and routine maintenance performed by a professional contractor.
- Replace your furnace filter to increase efficiency; and change it monthly if you have pets, smokers or people with breathing difficulties living in your home.
- Make sure your furnace and water heater are properly ventilated and clear of obstructions.
- Seal up seams and cracks around walls, windows, doors and fixtures to reduce drafts.
- Check that vents and registers are dust-free and not blocked by furniture, draperies or rugs, allowing heat to circulate.

An Important Safety Message

Corrugated Stainless Steel Tubing (CSST) is a flexible, stainless steel pipe with a yellow (or in some cases, black) exterior plastic coating used to supply natural gas and propane to some homes and businesses. It should be properly bonded and grounded. If lightning strikes on or near a structure, there is risk it can travel through the structure's natural gas piping and cause a leak and, in some cases, a fire. If work has been performed on the natural gas piping system in your home or business since 1990, it's possible that CSST was installed but not to current installation requirements.

If you find CSST, it is strongly recommended you contact a licensed electrician to ensure your system is properly bonded. For more information, concerning the safety of CSST go to csstsafety.com.
