The Heat is On – Are You Ready? Heating season is on its way. Remember ... a little

Heating season is on its way. Remember ... a little preparation can go a long way toward saving on your energy bills! So, don't forget to:

- Ensure your heating system is operating at peak performance with a preseason inspection and routine maintenance performed by a professional heating contractor.
- Replace your furnace filter before the heating season begins to increase efficiency and change it monthly if you have pets, smokers or people with breathing difficulties living in your home.
- Make sure your furnace and hot water heater are properly ventilated and clear of obstructions.
- Seal up seams and cracks around walls, windows, doors and fixtures to reduce drafts.
- Check that vents and registers are dust-free and not blocked by furniture, draperies or rugs, allowing heat to circulate.
- Reverse your ceiling fan motor so warm air is driven back down into the room, resulting in more even heating.

Winterize Your Home

Now is the time to get your home ready for the cold months ahead. So whether you're closing up a summer home or leaving your home for an extended period during the winter, here are some suggestions to help you winterize your home – saving energy and money along the way:

- Adjust the thermostat to 50 degrees to help keep water pipes from freezing and bursting. (You can also install a low-temperature sensor that alerts your alarm monitoring center when the temperature in your home drops below a designated temperature.)
- Unplug electrical appliances and avoid energy hogs to save money and energy.
- Turn off your water from the main source and open all taps to drain anything left to avoid pipes from freezing.

Proper access will help us restore your service promptly in the event of a natural gas service disruption and help you avoid any potential property damage.

Get Set for Safety

Don't forget to set your clocks back to standard time on Sunday, November 4. And while you're at it change the batteries in your smoke and carbon monoxide (CO) detectors. When homes are sealed up against cold weather, there is a greater chance of dangerous build up of CO. So please take a few minutes to get set for safety.
