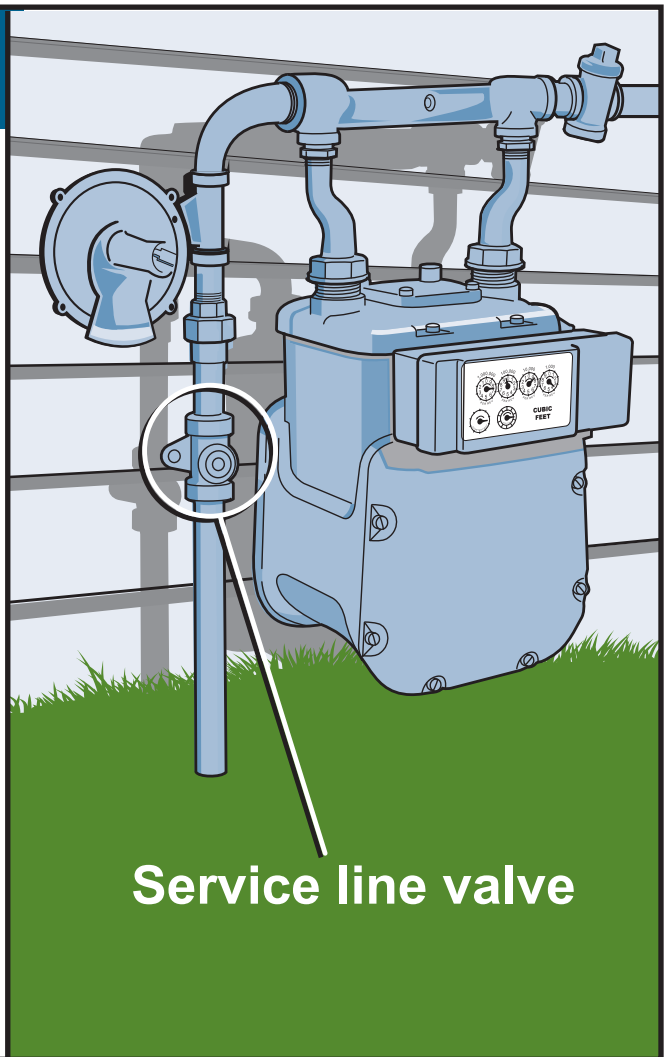
Spring Cleaning? Don't Forget About Meter Safety.

Your natural gas meter must remain free of debris and unobstructed at all times. This will allow safe and easy access for our meter readers and our technicians during routine maintenance or in case of an emergency.

Please ensure your service line valve isn't buried under landscaping or hardscaping (stones, bricks, etc.); it should look like the illustration to the right. You can read more information on the Gas Meter Safety tab under the My Safety section of njng.com.

- Please keep the area around your meter free from mulch, plants, etc.
- Use caution when mowing your lawn or operating equipment around your meter.
 - Don't lean ladders against the meter.
- Never tie anything – including a dog leash or ground wire – to a meter or its piping.
- Don't box in your meter or build a deck around or above it.
