Celebrating 15 Years of Building Affordable Housing

Healthy, robust communities create opportunities that allow residents to live deeper, richer lives. And for the past 15 years, our long-standing relationship with the Asbury Park nonprofit organization Interfaith Neighbors has helped hard-working families realize the American Dream of owning a home when they otherwise would have been unable to. It is from this partnership that the NJNG Home Ownership Program was born.

The program dates back to December 1997 when Interfaith Neighbors completed its first home renovation of a dilapidated and abandoned house in Asbury Park, resulting from an initial \$25,000 donation from NJNG. Since that time, we have collaboratively renovated or constructed a total of 33 homes in Asbury Park, Neptune and Long Branch.

Over the years NJNG's Home Ownership Program has grown to include affordable housing in Morris and Ocean Counties. Partnering with community organizations Homes for All (Ocean County) and Morris Habitat for Humanity (Morris County), we have helped 36 families become first-time homeowners in those areas as well.

We are proud to work side-by-side with our partners to advance the development of underserved areas while helping families realize their dream of homeownership.
