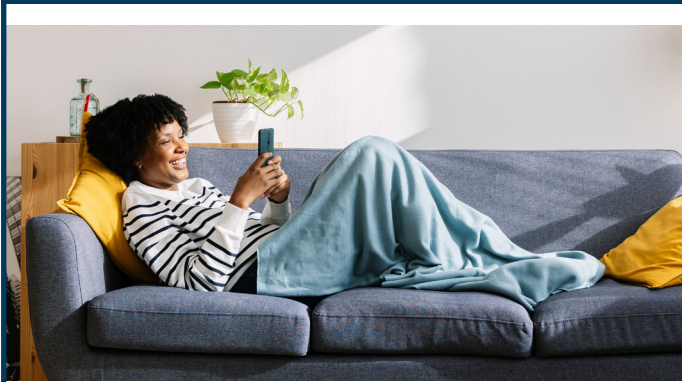

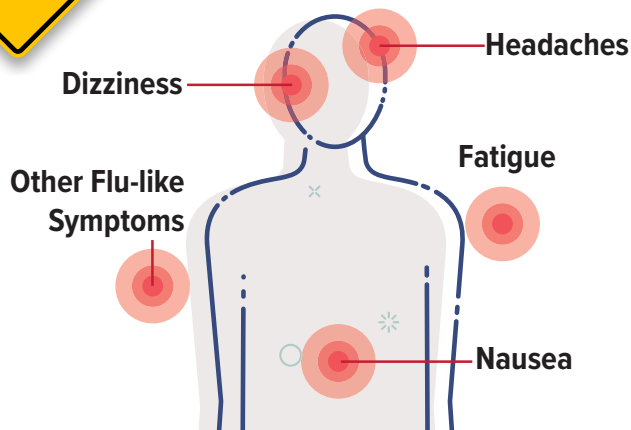

# Understanding Your Natural Gas Bill


Your natural gas bill is made up of several components. The price of your natural gas service is reflected as “This Service Period Gas Charges” in the Bill Calculation section of your bill. NJNG determines what you owe (gas charges) each month by multiplying the BGS (Basic Gas Supply) and DEL (Delivery) rates by the total therms (billable unit of natural gas) you used, then adding the customer charge. The total makes up the natural gas charges in the service period, which is regulated by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities.

**The BGS (Basic Gas Supply)** portion of your bill is the cost of the natural gas supply passed directly to customers. This means the price we pay is the price you pay (as mandated by law) — unless you've selected a third-party supplier. The BGS price represents the "price to compare" with third-party supplier offers. If you purchase your natural gas from a third-party supplier, charges appear as GAS on your NJNG bill.

The **DEL (Delivery)** charge is for the delivery of natural gas to your home or business and maintenance of our distribution system. It also includes charges for societal benefits programs related to environmental and energy-efficiency initiatives.

**The Residential Customer Charge** offsets a portion of billing, meter reading and related equipment.

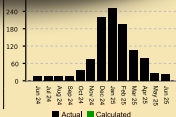
