Planning an outdoor project? Know what's below before you dig.

Attention homeowners, businesses and contractors ...

Whether it's sprucing up a garden, planting a tree, installing a mailbox or building a deck — all projects big and small **require a call to 811 for a free markout of underground utility lines**. This simple call will help you avoid costly repairs, fines, vital service disruptions and serious accidents. So, drop that shovel and call 811 — **it's free and it's the law.**

Important Notice: Call 811 Before You Dig

Attention homeowners, businesses and contractors — before you start any digging project, remember to:

Plan Ahead: Call 811 at least three business days before digging as required by law.

Wait for the Markout. Utility companies will mark out underground lines — natural gas, water, electricity and cable — with color-coded flags or paint.

Respect the Marks. Dig carefully, using hand tools within 36 inches of the marked location to avoid damage and the disruption of vital services.
